workshops led by industry professionals on the ground.




PEER SUPPORT

HOW DO IDEX FELLOWS MAKE A DIFFERENCE?


Fellows begin their journey when they are carefully screened and matched with host organizations. They are placed in social enterprises in the sub-sectors of food and agriculture, education, education technology, impact investing, information communication technology, clean energy, public policy and sanitation/water. In short, Fellows use their education and skills to address social and economic challenges for underserved populations.

YOUR INVESTMENT

The IDEX Accelerator is a tuition-based, professional development program. Program tuition for the six-month program is \$3,500 USD (\$2,000 USD for participants from developing economies).

- Tuition covers all education expenses of the program, including: Inspiration Conference, capacity building workshops/webinars, program curriculum, field training workshops, and associated lodging/travel from training site to placement city.
- Tuition does not cover airfare or travel to/from placement city, visa costs, or daily living expenses during the program such as food or utilities.

SCHOLARSHIP FUNDS

Through funding from generous sponsors, IDEX is able to offer a limited number of scholarships to select candidates for use towards the IDEX Accelerator program tuition. The scholarship deadline is December 15. Late applications will not be accepted.
