THE OPPORTUNITY

Subject matter of work varies by CBO division and unit.

POLICY ANALYSTS/ECONOMISTS

- Have doctoral or master's degree in economics, public policy, public health, or related field.
- Conduct research, draft Congressional testimony; and write cost estimates, memoranda and studies.

ASSISTANT ANALYSTS

- Provide support to the division on a wide variety of topics by maintaining models and assisting in data manipulation and analysis for projects.
- o Have an undergraduate degree in economics, public policy, or related field.

INTERNS

- Typically full-time graduate students who work on various CBO projects for a 10-week appointment during the summer.
- Application period is mid-December through February 29, 2016.

All positions require superior technical skills as well as strong oral and written communication skills, especially the ability to communicate technical matters clearly and concisely. Successful candidates must be able to work independently and complete projects in a timely manner.

Non U.S. citizens who are permanent residents of the U.S. seeking citizenship are eligible.
